

Where Do The Children Play?

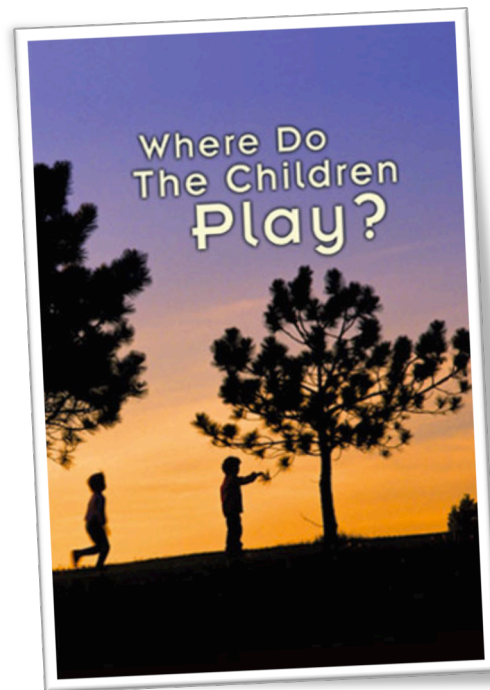
