- 1. Opening Reception. On Sunday August 3rd, an opening reception will allow all participants to meet one another as well as colleagues in the University of Michigan community.
- 2. Workshops. Five of the senior scholars will each conduct a 2-hour workshop on some aspect of her or his research work focusing on practical methodological issues. The same workshop will be conducted three times during the week, and groups of students and junior scholars will rotate through the workshops over the course of the event.
- 3. Colloquia. Each senior scholar will present a 1 hour presentation on his or her research program inclusive of time for questions, discussion, etc. All participants will be expected to attend all colloquia.
- **4. Individual tutorials**. Each student and each junior scholar will be invited to submit a work in progress of article length ahead of time, or a briefer summary of planned work. Each senior scholar will be appointed five tutees (from among the fifty students and junior scholars) and will spend one hour with each, offering suggestions for future work and feedback on their work in progress.
- **5. Seminars**. Five of the senior scholars will each select key readings in the field to organize a seminar discussion among the fifty students and junior scholars. As with the workshops, the same seminar will be held three times during the event, and groups of students and junior scholars will rotate through the workshops over the course of the event.
