



Jigsaw Model Expert Group Worksheet

EXPERT GROUP TEACHING GOAL

Teach the topic to their home group members well enough that the home group members would be able to teach the topic to another person.

NON-EXPERT'S JOB DURING HOME GROUP TIME

The non-expert's job during this teaching time is to ask questions of the expert and probe the topic well enough so that by the end of the 15 minute session everyone in the home group understands the topic well enough to teach it to someone else. All group members must be prepared to present on all expert topics.
