Equity and diversity in higher education is at once desired and elusive. It is not uncommon for equity and diversity initiatives to ebb and flow, wax and wane, as frequently as strategic plans get revised, new initiatives launched, and which dissipate when senior university leaders move on to other positions and universities. Adding to this challenge is the reality that it is just as uncommon to find Asian Americans in these senior university leaders position in higher education, thus creating both a vacuum of diverse Asian voices, perspectives, representation, role models, and professional kinships. Dr. Goh will share his personal and professional drive to do this work, what he has learned from scholarship and scandals, and he invites honest and heartfelt discussion about the hopes and challenges that confront us in the daily grind of doing the work.
