

Submission Guidelines

Journal of Arabic Linguistics Tradition (JALT) welcomes scholarly articles and book reviews that contribute to a proper and principled understanding of the Arabic linguistics tradition, encompassing the whole range of phonological, morphological, syntactic, semantic, and other related analyses and the specific contribution of linguists since the tradition's earliest inception (around the 8th Century) until the 15th Century. The journal accepts articles in English and Arabic. The journal also welcomes translation articles, especially those accompanied by commentary and/or analysis sections.

Manuscripts submitted to the journal should be accompanied by an abstract not exceeding 200 words in addition to 7-10 key words. Authors should submit an electronic copy in .pdf and another in MS Word format with all the special characters properly embedded. All copies should be printed in double spacing. Footnotes should appear at the foot of the relevant page. IPA symbols must be used throughout except with proper names, in which case authors are advised to follow IPA or the common spelling of such names.

Article length: 8,000 words (Times New Roman, 12 pt.). Book review length: 1,000-1,500 words (Times New Roman, 12 pt.). Articles and reviews previously published in print or online will not be accepted.
