High Level Summary

The PROMPT study aims to reduce the burden of depression through expanding use of mobile technology interventions. PROMPT gathers data from study participants' mobile fitness devices (FitBit and Apple watch), including activities, weight, calories and other data.

Example Use Case

A researcher could investigate the relationship between step count and blood pressure readings in study participants.
